Ask4Hearts Convention

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Ask4Hearts Introduction and Objectives

The convention allows responder to a minor suit opening to "Ask for hearts" and to "Ask if 4 Hearts" by bidding two of the other minor: 1 - 2, 1 - 2.

Responder's bid shows a game force and is artificial, asking opener to show 4♥s. The bid does not promise ♥s, and can be made on a balanced hand, with or without a four card major, or can have length in a minor. The bid denies a five card or longer major. After a 1♦ opening, game forcing hands with long ♣s continue to bid 2♣, even though it is Ask4Hearts.

Objectives of Ask4Hearts:

- Allow balanced hands the capability to explore for the best spot without treating the hands as suit oriented hand or disclosing unnecessary information.
- Establish a game force immediately, so that the opponents will be reluctant to interfere, and if they do, the partnership has available penalty doubles and forcing passes (i.e. the player who first has to act can pass, knowing partner will take some action).
- Provide a forcing bid when responder has a game force in either minor.

After the Ask4Hearts bid, opener will always bid 2NT if 18-19 balanced, and otherwise with $4+\Psi s$ will always make the cheapest bid not including 2Ψ (1 - 2 - 2 - 2 = 1 -

Here is the structure of opener's rebids after 1 - 2 and 1 - 2:

After opener's $2 \checkmark$ rebid $(1 - 2 \checkmark - 2 \checkmark)$ or $1 \div 2 \checkmark - 2 \checkmark$ or $1 \div 2 \checkmark - 2 \checkmark$ denying $4 + \checkmark$ s and showing minimum or $4 \checkmark$ s, opener with $4 \checkmark$ s can bid naturally with $2 \checkmark$ or 2NT. 2NT does not promise $4 \checkmark$ s, but requires opener to show them, if held, by bidding $3 \checkmark$, artificial (opener has already denied $4 \checkmark$ s, so $3 \checkmark$ is used to transfer to show $4 \checkmark$ s). This allows a $3 \checkmark$ rebid by opener to show $5 \checkmark$ s.

Aside from the 3♥ rebid to show 4♠s, the bidding continues naturally, with two other exceptions:

1) 1 + 2 - 2 - 2 shows 4 + 4s, asks for further description. This keeps the bidding low with 4s.

2) If either player has denied four cards in a major (by skipping over the bid that would show it), a major suit bid by either player is value showing. This allows stoppers to be shown for 3NT.
